

Guidelines on security measures and rules of conduct for foreign citizens at SPbGASU

When in the buildings and on the grounds of SPbGASU, foreign citizens and stateless persons must comply with the safety measures and rules of conduct established by the legislation of the Russian Federation, as well as local regulations of SPbGASU, in particular the rules for access control and internal security.

Foreign students and stateless persons are also required to comply with the requirements of the Internal Regulations for Students at SPbGASU and the Regulations on the Student Dormitory of SPbGASU.

The SPbGASU's local regulations are posted on the official SPbGASU website (<http://spbgasu.ru>).

Students can enter the university using electronic passes or student cards.

Your pass and student ID card are non-transferable, and using someone else's pass is prohibited. Security has the right to inspect your pass. You must present it upon request.

If your pass is lost, you must contact the pass office (where you received it).

Students are allowed to enter the university buildings from 08:00 to 22:00 on weekdays (including Saturday).

Access to the dormitory for resident students is available at any time.

Prohibited are:

Bringing and consuming alcoholic beverages, including beer, is prohibited.

Smoking tobacco, using tobacco (in any form), and using or storing hookahs are prohibited.

Possession, use, or distribution of narcotics is prohibited.

Being under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or other intoxicants is prohibited.

Bringing weapons, ammunition, or other dangerous items is prohibited.

Open flames are prohibited.

If you notice any disturbances or foreign objects that may be explosives, notify security.

If you find something abandoned, hand it over to security.

If you or a friend is injured, notify security. Security has first aid kits.

If you notice a fire, call 112 and notify security.

If the fire alarm sounds and an evacuation is ordered, leave the building immediately.
